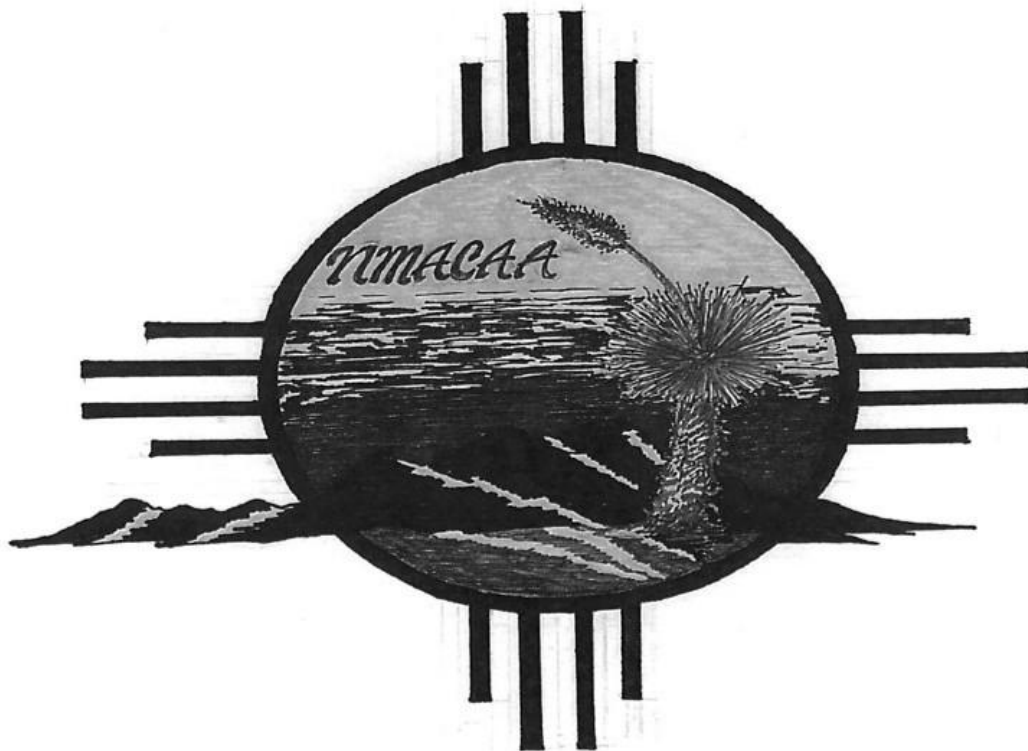

College Scholarship Application



New Mexico Association of County Agricultural Agents Foundation Scholarship Guidelines

1. The scholarship is available to current or lifetime NMACCA members' immediate family members for one year of continuing education at an institution of their choice. "Immediate family" is defined as the NMACAA member's spouse and children. The spouse must be living in the same household. Children can be natural, adopted through marriage (stepchildren), or through legal guardianship.
2. NMACAA Foundation scholarships are a one-year scholarship. Persons who receive a scholarship may reapply each year. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of funds available and the applicant's eligibility.
3. No one will be disqualified because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.
4. To apply, submit a resume, along with a cover letter which addresses future plans and goals, to the address below. **Applications must be received by May 30, 2026.** Scholarships will be awarded by the middle of June.
